# LGBTQIA+ Caregiver Social Networks

## About this Study

This study aims to learn more about the social and caregiving support networks of LGBTQIA+ people who provide care for loved ones living with Alzheimer's Disease or other forms of dementia. Further understanding these networks will aid development of programs to help caregivers and improve patient outcomes.

## You may be eligible if you...

- Are a primary caregiver of a person living with Alzheimer's Disease or other other forms of dementia
- Identify as a sexual or gender minority (i.e., LGBTQIA+).
- Are at least 18 years of age

## What's involved?

This study involves completing a guided survey on Zoom with a member of the research team. This interview would last less than one hour.

Prior to starting, you would complete a short screening phone call and fill out an online survey including basic information about you (age, gender, race, ethnicity). We would then schedule your Zoom interview to talk about your role as a caregiver and the people who support you.

We would also ask you to provide contact information for certain people in your network to complete a paid follow up survey.

Participation in this research study is voluntary. If you decide participate in this research, you will receive an e-gift card (Amazon.com) upon completing your interview.
